
FEMALE GENITAL SCHISTOSOMIASIS (FGS)

What is the treatment?

- It prevents the development of FGS
- It prevents existing symptoms of FGS from getting worse

When to take treatment:

- It does not prevent someone from becoming reinfected
- Therefore, you should take treatment every <u>6 months</u>, if you touch dirty water

PRAZIQUANTEL

Side effects:

- They are usually mild and can include headaches, stomach aches, dizziness, nausea, fatigue or fever
- You should **eat in advance** to avoid them
